The Auld Kirk: A Historic Gem

The A-listed Auld Kirk of St Monans has stood as a beacon of faith, community, and history since 1362. Perched on the Fife coastline, this remarkable building replaced an earlier shrine and is unique in its setting and architecture. From its octagonal stone spire to its stunning coastal views, the Auld Kirk tells the story of generations who have worshipped, celebrated, and sought solace within its walls.

- Restoration and Preservation: Undertaking essential repairs to maintain the Kirk's structural integrity and beauty and providing upgraded WC/kitchen facilities..
- Community Events: Hosting concerts, exhibitions, and celebrations within the Kirk's unique setting.
- **Heritage Displays**: To share the Kirk's history and significance with visitors.
- A Place for Reflection: Maintaining the Kirk as a serene space for worship, meditation, and personal connection.
- Sustainable Income Generation: Hosting occasional event rentals, such as weddings, and establishing a community café to support the ongoing maintenance and operation of the Kirk as a community building.

Our Journey So Far

Since 2022 when the Church of Scotland shared its plans to sell The Auld Kirk, we have made significant progress towards purchasing it for the community. Thanks to funding from The Architectural Heritage Fund, The Scottish Land Fund, other funders, donors and local business., we have now have a full business plan, architectural concept and costed surveys for the repairs. The next step is gathering community support through membership to allow us to move forward with obtaining funding to purchase The Kirk.
